NAIDOC Week

The Victorian Early Years Learning Development Framework (VEYLDF) guides early childhood professionals to work together with families in support of their children, embracing and responding to the cultural and linguistic diversity of the Victorian community and diverse approaches to child rearing.

In particular, the VEYLDF:

- recognises and respects Aboriginal cultures and their unique place in the heritage and future of Victoria. Learning about and valuing the place of Aboriginal people will enhance all Victorian children's sense of place in our community (VEYLDF 2016)

Embedding Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture plays an important part in Family and Children's Services. NAIDOC week allows children to be part of a national program that celebrates the culture and contribution of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people past present and future. Educators involved children by providing story telling, music and art experiences during NAIDOC Week.
