



# Community Information Newsletter Cobden – Camperdown Peat Fires Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> March to Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2018

### **INCIDENT UPDATE**

Peat Fire is continuing to burn underground in the peat areas of Lake Elingamite, Cobrico Swamp, and Lake Bullen Merri.

**Terang, Camperdown, Gazette** and **Garvoc** fires are contained and all have been handed back to local CFA arrangements.

Crews are employing various strategies and firefighting tactics to extinguish the peat fires.

Specialist Compressed Air Foam System (CAFs) equipment from Latrobe Valley and Tasmania is

being used to assist with both minimising smoke and Carbon Monoxide around the Peat Fires.

Community members around the *active* peat fires near Cobrico and Lake Elingamite need to be aware of the risks of peat smoke and understand what it means.

If you are within 1km – 6km of the peat smoke plume it is recommended you avoid outdoor physical activity, anyone with a heart or lung condition should take their medication as prescribed.

# PERSONAL WELFARE

It is normal to have strong emotional or physical reactions after an emergency – these feelings are part of the healing process. Here are some strategies for coping with <u>trauma in recovery</u>. In families, each person reacts in their own way after an emergency. Understanding each other and some of the common reactions to look out for can help your family.
