Stage 1: Twelve Apostles Trail Project

August 2023



What's happened since the last update?

- Completed construction of Campbells Creek bridge footings
- Kerb and channel poured on Great Ocean Road, east of Campbells Creek bridge
- Started fencing works on east side of Campbells Creek bridge, with holes dug for fencing
- Continued path construction and fencing on the east of the Great Ocean Road lookout
- Construction commenced on retaining wall near bus shelter
- Continued works for underground drain near bus shelter, works almost complete
- Wannon Water sewer pipeline completed and tested
- Seating installed at lookout carpark

What's next?

- Offsite fabrication of cantilever boardwalk for north of the lookout
- Landscaping at GOR lookout car park and Desailly Street traffic island
- Continue path construction works between GOR lookout and Campbells Creek
- Complete underground drain construction near bus shelter
- Campbells Creek bridge to be erected
- Finalise shop drawings for boardwalks opposite Port Campbell-Curdievale Road and on Great Ocean Road between cutting and Campbells Creek
- Drainage improvement works on North South Road
- Replace missing trail related road signs

Concrete contrast...

You may have noticed a difference in the concrete colours on the path between the lookout and Campbells Creek bridge.

The same dye colour has been used in the concrete pour, but the difference in the weather conditions, less sun, as well as a longer curing period has meant the concrete path appears to be different colours.

The darker shade path will fade off to match whats already been in place for some time.
