Stage 1: Twelve Apostles Trail Project

What's happened since the last update?

- Lookout car park opened for use
- Earthworks, concreting, retaining wall and fencing for part of the concrete path east of the Great Ocean Road lookout
- Completed civil works at Desailly Street and McCue Street intersections
- Started installing Wannon Water sewer pipe
- Completed handrail system, fencing and connections on cattle underpass bridges completed
- Telstra industry expert on site to inform works in vicinity of Telstra assets
- Repair works on trail where scouring has occurred on sections of trail on North South Road

What's next?

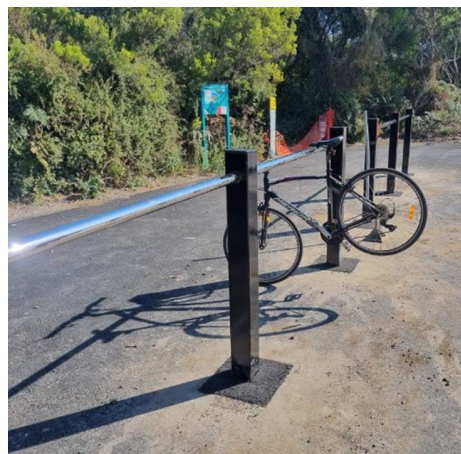
- Clean up outstands, topsoil and landscaping at GOR lookout car park and Desailly Street and McCue Street intersections. Annie Schofield and Kim Morton are providing native planting expertise
- Install bike symbol plaques on bike rack at car park
- Continue construction works to path east of the GOR lookout
- Footing installation for bridge/ boardwalks
- Complete Wannon Water sewer pipe installation
- Start construction works near bus shelter
- Complete screen, fencing and signage at cattle underpass bridges. Final material to connect trail to bridges.
- Repair works on trail where scouring has occurred on sections of trail on Curdievale Port Campbell Road and Timboon Peterborough Road
- Replace missing trail related road signs

Project timeline

Due to skilled labour and staff shortages with supply contractors, Council regrets to advise the project timeline will be extended.

The three boardwalks and one bridge will be fabricated offsite, footings will be installed prior to the wet weather ready for the structures to be craned into place.

Final construction is expected to be completed in November.
