## Stage 1: Twelve Apostles Trail Project

November 2022



### What's happened since the last update?

We have spent a lot of time over the past month locating Telstra assets, including fibre optic and copper cables that run along Campbells Creek and connect the town. The thoroughness of this process means we alleviate any potential issues during construction.

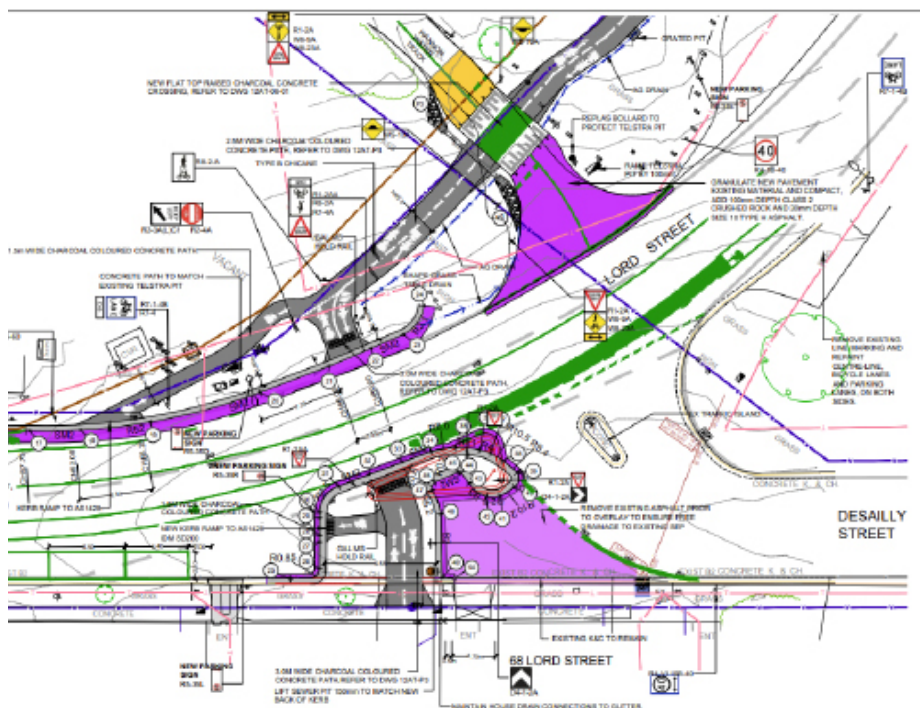
The two cattle underpass bridges are still being built offsite, with works happening onsite at both locations on the approaches to these bridges. We anticipate the two of these bridges will be installed before Christmas.

### What's next: Plans for entrance at Lord/Desailly Streets

Works have started on the look-out car park and this will be completed and open by Christmas.

Please note that there will be traffic control, speed reductions and/or lane closures at Lord Street and Desailly Street between now and Christmas while these works take place. They will be finished before peak season traffic.



### Project timeline

#### May 2020

Corangamite Shire commits \$2.22M to Stage 1 of the Twelve Apostles Trail in its 2020-2021 Budget.

#### August 2020

Victorian Government commits \$4.5M to the project.

#### July-December 2020

Power Creek Reserve Trail completed.

#### January 2021-May 2022

Haywards Road to Curdievale Port Campbell Road completed.

#### March 2021-May 2022

Curdievale Port Campbell Road completed.

#### September 2021-June 2022

Glerums Road to Haywards Road completed.

#### May-August 2022

Great Ocean Road to look-out.

#### October-December 2022

Great Ocean Road lookout carpark. Lord Street and two cattle underpass bridges to be installed.

#### October 2022-June 2023

Great Ocean Road lookout to Campbells Creek.

#### February-June 2023

Port Campbell to Campbells Creek.

#### April-June 2023

Campbells Creek pedestrian bridge
