IMMUNISATION

For the quarter October - December the Australian Immunisation Register has recorded the following data relating to coverage in the Corangamite Shire:

- 12 -< 15 months: 100% of children in the Shire fully vaccinated
- 24 <27 months : 92.11% of children in the Shire are fully vaccinated
- 60 -< 63 months: 95.83% of children are fully vaccinated

We are meeting the 95% aspirational target rate in most age groups.

The Commonwealth Child Dental Benefits Schedule provides assistance for basic dental treatment over a two-year period for eligible 2–17 year olds

2-17 year olds are eligible if they receive Family Tax Benefit A External website icon or other relevant Australian Government payments

Treatment is bulk billed through Medicare
