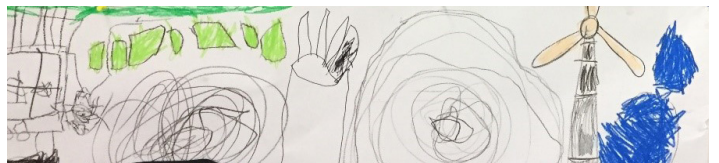

# KINDERGARTEN NEWS

## SCHOOL READINESS FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PROJECTS

This year our funded kindergarten services have been able to access additional School readiness funding. This funding will provide extra support to our kindergartens to help more children reach school developmentally on track.

Catharine Hydon and Gilda Howard have been engaged to work with all our kindergarten teachers to deliver a family engagement project through the School Readiness Funding.

Gilda and Catharine visited our kindergartens during the second week of June.

The aim of the project is to improve children's language and literacy skills, with particular focus on Emergent literacy. Emergent literacy is used to explain a child's knowledge of reading and writing skills before they learn how to read and write words.

**Over the next few months we will be highlighting what's happening individual kindergarten services.**

Western Plains Mobile Preschool

The families at Western Plains Mobile preschool are participating in 1000 Books before School to promote early literacy



skills. Reading just ten minutes a day can instill a lifelong love of books and learning in young children. The children have enjoyed showcasing their favorite story books each week.

The children are visiting the DerrianiLlum library every second Thursday to borrow & change books using their library cards. Julie, the librarian at DerrianiLlum library has mentioned to Sarah she has enjoyed building the relationships with the children and ensuring the DerrianiLlum Library is an inviting and accessible space for all community members. Julie has been very supportive of the Family Engagement Project.

If you would like to participate in the 1000 books before school project you can register at any one of the local participating libraries. A library membership may be required to join the program.

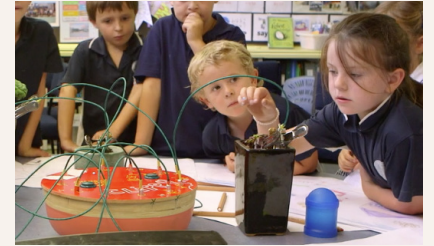
